

Youth Leader Position

Webster UCC is looking for a Youth Leader to provide Webster's youth with a spiritual support network by facilitating fellowship, spiritual discussions and community service opportunities. Qualifications for this position are basic Biblical knowledge, enthusiasm, and a young-at-heart mindset. Preferably, the youth leader will be at least 25 years old. Time spent performing the responsibilities of this position are expected to be about 8 hours per week, including preparation/planning time and interaction with the youth. Job description

The goal of the Youth Leader is to provide Webster's youth (grades 6-12) with a spiritual support network by facilitating fellowship, spiritual discussions and community service opportunities.

- 1) Develop a communication system with the youth (via email or if needed, phone).
- 2) Coordinate youth activities:
 - a) Have a planning meeting once/month at the church which includes a time for fellowship (such as pizza and movie) and a spiritual component, such as prayer and/or bible study.
 - b) At least every other month, plan other activities including field trips (single day or one night activities only), community service, and fundraisers. Examples of these activities may include bowling, rock climbing, Global Village, work at Webster Garden, and bake sales.
- 3) Coordinate communication about planned activities with the Pastor and the Board of Christian Education. After this communication, all youth activities should be posted on the church calendar if there are no conflicts for the chosen date (questions about conflicts should be discussed with the Pastor and the Board of Christian Education).
- 4) Follow the procedures of the Webster UCC Pilot Safe Children Program. This will include obtaining permission slips and making sure that there are enough adult chaperones for activities.
